"Unexplained Occurrences"

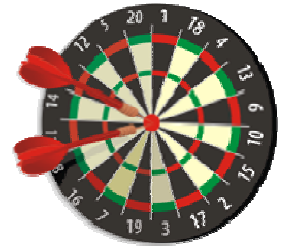
