## RULES & PROCEDURES

### I. What is Speed Dating

*It's SAFE, FUN, & FAST!!*

No more personal ads, blind dates or bar scene pick-ups. Where else can you meet a dozen or more people at one time who are there for the same reason you are?

"Speed Dating" events are a modern way to bring single professionals together in casual, fun and pressure-free environments. Everyone's been talking about it, and you've probably seen the concept on popular TV shows such as Sex and The City and in the movie Hitch.

### II. HOW IT WORKS

#### **Register:**

Step one is to register for the Speed Dating event by visiting our website at [www.watertownjaycees.org](http://www.watertownjaycees.org). Fill out the [Registration Form](#), select payment method ([PayPal](#) or Check). If you are mailing a check, please send it to Greater Watertown Jaycees PO Box 6364 Watertown, NY 13601.

Once we receive your Registration Form and Payment, we'll send you an e-mail confirmation of your registration. Seating is limited, so if we don't receive your Registration Form and Payment before the specified deadline, you may be denied.

#### **Sign In:**

Plan to arrive at least 30 minutes before the official start time to sign-in and mingle. We will begin promptly at **5:30pm**

#### **The Big Event!**

At each event, there will be an equal number of men and women. We facilitate the whole thing so you are guaranteed to meet everyone. We will give each participant a Welcome Pack, including a name tag (with your first name and a number only) and a 3x5 card. A cash bar will be available for soft drinks or something stiffer (please drink responsibly). There will also be drink and appetizer specials.

**We will review the Ground Rules a few minutes before the start time...you do NOT disclose your last name, where you live or work, phone number, etc. Nor do you ask someone out during the event itself...no pressure!**

At the start of the event, everyone puts on a nametag with only your first name and a number. The event is organized so that you will chat, ask questions, and check out the chemistry with everyone in a string of one-on-one conversations lasting 3 minutes each. At the end of the 3 minutes, a bell will ring, and you will have time to mark your score card if you liked or disliked the person. The men will then move to the next seat.

The process continues until everyone has met. The event itself will last for about an hour. You are then welcome to stay and mingle for awhile, take the opportunity to meet other people who are there to meet others just like you, and learn more about the Greater Watertown Jaycees!

#### **It's a Match! (or two, or three, or more...)**

After the event, we will compile the information from everyone's Score Cards to determine who matches up. If two people mutually checked "YES," then that's a match (odds are you'll have one or more matches). You'll receive a private e-mail within the next few days after the event listing the first names and e-mail addresses or phone numbers of the people you matched with. From there, it's up to you to contact one another to learn more about each other and set up another date.

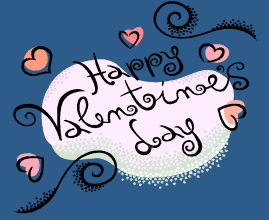




## Contest Rules

1. Registration begins on January 19, 2011, and is done either electronically or via mail. Registration forms are available [here](#). Contestants must pre-register by February 23 to guarantee their spot.
  2. **Only the first 25 acts registered will perform.** If more than 25 registrations are taken, you will be notified and kept as an alternate act.
  3. At least one person in your group must live within the Town of Clayton or Town of Orleans in order to enter into the contest.
  4. You may be in only ONE act per category. The oldest person in the group determines the category.
  5. You must check in by 6:30 p.m. on the night of the show or you may not be able to perform.
  6. The show begins at 7:00 p.m., and is expected to last 2 hours.
  7. You are responsible for all of your own props. This includes instruments, microphones, etc.
  8. Entrance fee for each participant is \$5.00 or \$10.00 for a group.
  9. Your group or individual must supply their own CD in good condition for their performance. You will get your music back! Mark your music with your name, phone number, and track number.
  10. Maximum time limit for your performance or song will be limited to no more than 3 minutes 30 seconds in length. Please understand that we are under a time limit. It is only fair to all that we use the same time limit. At 3 minutes 30 seconds all music will be faded out.
  11. All songs and performances must be in good taste! This is a family event for all ages. Any performance done in poor taste will be interrupted and that performer will be disqualified.
  12. Amateur performers only. No professional groups are allowed to perform.
  13. As an act in the Lip Sync Contest you agree to allow us to use any likenesses, videos, or photographs taken of you during your act in Lip Sync Contest promotional materials.
  14. The competition will be judged in these categories:
    - o **Lip Sync Abilities:** How well the performer(s) lip-sync the lyrics of the song.
    - o **Creativity:** How original and creative the performance is. Instead of just standing on stage and lip-syncing a song, props, costumes and/or other ideas should be used and often impresses the judges and generates crowd response. Be creative!
    - o **Stage Presence & Choreography:** Again, don't just stand there! Engage the audience, dance, smile, make eye contact with the judges...have fun!
- Each category will be worth 10 points each. In case of a tie, the act with the highest lip sync score will win. The Judges decisions are final! A second prize for the Audience Choice will also be awarded.**
